

## ASSISTANCE FOR FAMILIES WITH RENT / MORTGAGE CRISIS

For low and moderate-income Broward families who are unemployed or under-employed and have a significant amount of debt/lack access to affordable banking products; lack services to help improve household finances; or are at risk for eviction or foreclosure due to job or income loss related to COVID-19.

Families may meet ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) criteria; be undocumented residents, or have landlords who are unwilling to accept terms of existing CARES funding.

## COVID-Related Financial Assistance

### Individual Coaching

- **Income Support:** assistance in accessing work supports and health care benefits.
- **Workforce Development:** assistance with self-sufficiency goals; connection to resources, employment, educational institutions, job leads, customized job fairs.
- **Financial Coaching:** coaching and access to financial products and services to improve household finances and build assets.
- **Benefits Support:** helping clients gain access to public benefits, tax credits, financial aid, and other benefits for financial security.

### Classes & Workshops

- **Financial Literacy:** banking basics; establishing, monitoring, and using credit; understanding savings plans; identity theft prevention; home buying; investing, and account enrollment.
- **Skills Training:** entry-level education or vocational programs for various career paths.
- **Workplace Excellence:** an employment education series that may include job searching, dress for success, embracing success, mock interviews, and resume writing.
