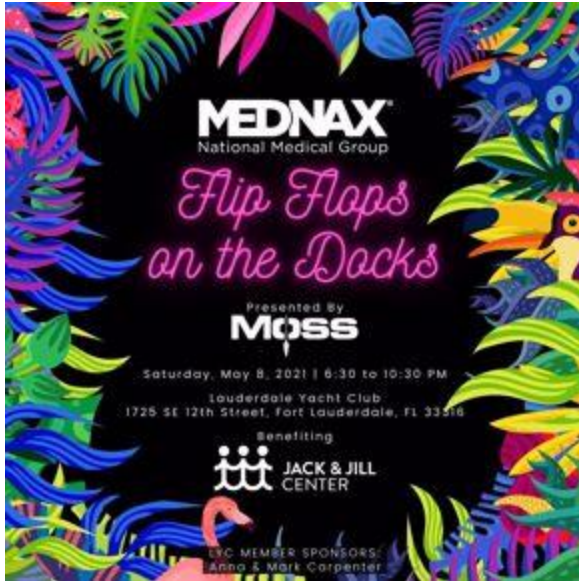


New Look—Same Mission We're Excited to Announce We're Rebranding!

Take A Tour of Madelaine Halmos Academy!

When Madelaine Halmos Academy opens, the program will enroll 220 students in Kindergarten through fifth grade, totaling the impact of Jack & Jill's education programs to 352 students. 37 new full-time jobs will also be created. The new school will feature 12 classrooms, an arts and science lab, a music and media lab, a rooftop play area and outdoor learning space, a wellness room, a dining hall with a restaurant-grade kitchen, and state-of-the-art security and technology.
